

In the art school and getting to know the basics, design and technique and color theory as well as getting to know the school of impressionism and using their teachings in my works according to the teacher>s request...














In this course, I made a great progression owing to my attendance at Tehran University and familiarity with geometric proportions, composition, practical basics, as well as choosing the nostalgic theme of grandmother's house by referring to memories and using mental images, especially light and shadow, and elements in architecture, compared to the time I was at Art School.



Upon the recommendations of teachers and educational topics, I started to stick to an existing and real subject and intelligently use the elements of practical basics (point, line, surface, texture, color, etc.) and use creativity and composition and simplify a subject to achieve a modern composition.











Keeping committed to the primary theme (alleys), by approaching the philosophy of Zen and the Taoist school and using the vast empty space, concise compositions and special color harmony, I was creating a new space that conveys the most feelings to me with the simplest technique.












Using the subject of lifeless nature and the achievements and studies that it can bring to a painter is a reason for reflection.


















I took various trips to India due to my personal interest in the ancient culture and customs and life of the people in this country.


Living in an artistic and art-loving family and having a father who was a calligraphy and painting artist was a gift given to me by God.



Different trainings during the education period at different stages led to the creation of paintings that were formed by combining calligraphy and painting.































Each relief pattern has a subject and a story behind it, which the artist creates, like the author of a book who narrates a simple event in such a way that it takes the viewer with him for hours.
